

2010 Holy Trinity Community Survey for Master Plan at 600 East Boulevard



In 2008, the church engaged the firm WKWW to develop a Master Plan for capital projects for the facilities at 600 East Boulevard and at Hellenic Park. The Master Plan was developed based upon input from the leaders of each ministry (such as Greek School, Sunday School, etc.) and resulted in the identification of capital projects for consideration. In order to continue the Master Planning process we need the community's input. We want to gather input regarding the capital projects in two phases. Phase I will involve gathering data for 600 East Boulevard. This phase is being done now. Phase II will involve gathering data for the capital projects at Hellenic Park (this phase will be completed next year). We are asking that you complete the enclosed survey so that we can identify which Master Planning projects the community feels are most important and are willing to support **at 600 East Boulevard**. Once the survey results are in, we will hold meetings with the community to determine what projects the community wants at 600 East Boulevard. We will then identify funding for the projects and ultimately move forward with securing funding and begin construction.
